Users access to the OLNA Dashboard	<p>The Principal and OLNA contacts have an account to access the OLNA Dashboard. Each account name is comprised of the school code and a letter:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Principal's account has an 'A' appended to the end, e.g. 0000A• OLNA Y10-12 Contact's account has a 'B', e.g. 0000B• OLNA Y9-10 Contact's account has a 'C', e.g. 0000C <p>The Principal's account has a function for creating additional users within the dashboard.</p> <p>Any new users for Term 2 Window A will need to reset their passwords.</p>
Students in the OLNA Dashboard	New students are loaded into the OLNA Dashboard between 9.00 am and 10.00 am each morning.
OLNA Checklists	<p>Schools are reminded that the <i>OLNA Handbook</i> contains important checklists (Appendices 5 and 6) that will assist schools in preparing for the OLNA.</p> <p>Schools are also reminded that all used and unused login sheets should be destroyed. New login sheets will be required for each window.</p>

	Results	Student results will be available via SIRS on Wednesday, 5 April 2023 .
	Reports available through SIRS	Reports have been updated to indicate where a student sat in the Term 1 window and the result for this window is not yet available. These students have had brackets placed around the achieved status from before this window. E.g. a student who currently has a status of (2): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sat in the Term 1 window • achieved category 2 before the Term 1 window.
Term 2 Window A	Test window	Writing: Monday, 1 May to Tuesday, 2 May Numeracy and Reading: Monday, 1 May to Friday, 12 May
	Cohort	Year 10, 11 and 12 students will be able to sit this window.
	Adjustments	All adjustments (for either disability or EAL/D) must be entered into the OLNA Dashboard by Thursday, 6 April 2023 . Students who do not have adjustments entered into the OLNA Dashboard by this date will need to sit without adjustments or wait until the next window.
	Declaration form	Submission of the completed OLNA Declaration form for the Term 2 Window A must be completed as soon as possible. If the current Principal has already signed the OLNA Declaration form for 2023, they are not required to complete another form and it is not required to be submitted again. If a Principal is new to the school, a form will need to be completed.
	Reports available through SIRS	The reports available in SIRS include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>LAN001 – OLNA Student list</i> (available Monday, 20 March) List of registered students eligible to sit the next OLNA window. • <i>LAN002 – OLNA Student Login Details</i> (available Monday, 24 April) Lists the usernames and passwords of students eligible to sit the upcoming OLNA window.
	Testing location	All students sitting an OLNA component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications such as <i>Grammarly</i> ® and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA.
	Results	Student results will be available via SIRS on Tuesday, 6 June 2023 .
