2024 windows	Test windows	The 2024 testing window dates are available on the Authority's website at https://senior-secondary.scsa.wa.edu.au/assessment/olna .
	Year 11 students Semester 1 sit	All Year 11 students are required to sit the OLNA, at least once, in one of the windows in Semester 1, 2024. After each window, schools should check students who are enrolled in Foundation courses whether the student is eligible for enrolment in Semester 2 Foundation courses. Schools that wait until Term 2 Window B before having a Year 11 Foundation student sit the OLNA run the risk of having to move the student from a Foundation to a General course during the start of Semester 2. (Results for this window will be released Week 1, Term 3.)
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications such as <i>Grammarly</i> ® and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA.
