Supporting visual material

The Interstate Language oral examination for Arabic and Vietnamese consists of two sections:

Section 1: Conversation. This section of the examination will be a general conversation between the candidate and the markers and is about the candidate's personal world and their interactions with the language and culture as learners; and

Section 2: Discussion. This section requires the candidate to discuss a chosen subtopic incorporating the supporting visual material.

The supporting visual material must be **one** image on a piece of paper no larger than A3 size. Three-dimensional objects are not permitted. The quality of the supporting visual material will not be assessed. The supporting visual material should not include any writing. If the supporting visual materials does contain writing, the amount of writing must be minimal e.g. a heading or a title. Candidates must not write on the supporting visual material.
