<b>General</b>	<b>Change of contact details</b>	If you are no longer an OLNA contact at the school to which this email was addressed, please forward to the new contact person or to another member of the school leadership team. If necessary, please have the contact details updated in SIRS.
	<b>OLNA Contacts</b>	There are two OLNA contact roles in SIRS. These roles, 'OLNA Y9–10' and 'OLNA Y10–12', will both receive all future OLNA updates and communications. Updating contacts in SIRS is self-administered by the school, and instructions on how to update contacts for 2023 can be found in Section 2 of the Data Procedures Manual available on The Authority website at <a href="https://www.scsa.wa.edu.au/publications/data-procedures-manual">https://www.scsa.wa.edu.au/publications/data-procedures-manual</a> .
	<b>Users access to the OLNA Dashboard</b>	The Principal and OLNA contacts have an account to access the OLNA Dashboard. Each account name is comprised of the school code and a letter: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Principal's account has an 'A' appended to the end, e.g. 0000A</li> <li>• OLNA Y10-12 Contact's account has a 'B', e.g. 0000B</li> <li>• OLNA Y9-10 Contact's account has a 'C', e.g. 0000C</li> </ul> <p>The Principal's account has a function for creating additional users within the dashboard.</p> <p>Any new users for Term 2 Window B will need to reset their passwords.</p>
	<b>Students in the OLNA Dashboard</b>	New students are loaded into the OLNA Dashboard between 9 am and 10 am each morning.
	<b>OLNA Checklists</b>	Schools are reminded that the <a href="#">OLNA Handbook</a> contains important checklists (Appendices 5 and 6) that will assist schools in preparing for the OLNA. Schools are also reminded that all used and unused login sheets should be destroyed. New login sheets will be required for each window.

	Reports available through SIRS	<p>The reports available in SIRS will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>LAN003 – OLN A Performance Overview</i> Lists the current OLN A results in each component for individual students of the selected cohort.</li> <li>• <i>LAN005 – OLN A Individual Student Diagnostics</i> Individual diagnostics for your current year students achieving a Category 1 or Category 2 result in the selected test window and component.</li> <li>• <i>LAN006 – OLN A Individual Student Current Status</i> This report includes current OLN A performance in each component for individual students.</li> <li>• <i>LAN011 – OLN A Student Accumulative Result</i> Lists the performance progression of registered students by test component.</li> </ul>

	Cohort	Year 10, 11 and 12 students will be able to sit this window.
	Declaration form	<p>Submission of the completed <a href="#">OLN A Declaration form</a> for the Term 2 Window B must be completed as soon as possible.</p> <p>If the current Principal has already signed the OLN A Declaration form for 2023, they are not required to complete another form and it is not required to be submitted again. If a Principal is new to the school, a form will need to be completed.</p>
	Reports available through SIRS	<p>The reports available via SIRS on <b>Tuesday, 6 June 2023</b>, include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>LAN001 – OLN A Student list</i> List of registered students eligible to sit the next OLN A window</li> <li>• <i>LAN002 – OLN A Student Login Details</i> Lists the usernames and passwords of students eligible to sit the upcoming OLN A window.</li> </ul>
	Testing location	All students sitting an OLN A component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications such as <i>Grammarly</i> ® and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLN A.
	Results	Student results will be available via SIRS on <b>Monday, 17 July 2023</b> .

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
