Year 12 students who have not demonstrated the minimum standard of literacy and numeracy	<p>To assist schools with reporting to parents about Year 12 students who have not met the literacy and numeracy standard (i.e. have not achieved Category 3 in one or more components) the Authority has developed the following resources which may be sent to parents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• a template letter• <i>The WACE 2024</i> – brochure.• <i>OLNA FAQs: for post Year 12 students who intend to re-sit the OLNA.</i>
Sitting OLNA at TAFE admissions (for entry into TAFE) while of compulsory school age	<p>TAFE admissions will run the OLNA for students seeking to enrol into TAFE courses for Semester 1, 2025. Testing will be held during October and November 2024.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will only be eligible to sit the OLNA at TAFE Admissions if they did not sit the OLNA in the six months preceding TAFE Admissions testing. If a student was enrolled for the Term 3 windows, but did not sit, the student will still be eligible to sit the OLNA at TAFE Admissions.• A student of compulsory school age who sits the OLNA with TAFE admissions will have this sit counted as one of their six opportunities.• In addition, Year 12 students who have had their six opportunities to sit the OLNA will not be eligible to re-sit the OLNA with TAFE admissions in 2024 while they are still of compulsory school age. <p>Students who will complete Year 12 in 2024 can only be enrolled to re-sit the OLNA with TAFE admissions either after they have turned 18 or after 31 December, 2024.</p>
