Indonesian: Background Language | ATAR Year 11 | Summary of minor syllabus changes for 2027

- The rationale has been updated as part of the WACE Refreshment.
- Minor edits (addition or deletion of a word, phrase or sentence) have been made throughout the syllabus to enhance clarity and ensure alignment across the background language courses. These include specifying the number of assessments (be limited to eight tasks or less instead of limited in number) in the Assessment section.

Content added and/or replaced

- Topic titles in Indonesian have been added to the English titles in each unit.
- Descriptions of each text type have been updated with refined or additional information to improve clarity.
- List of text types and styles of writing
 - ‘dialogue (script)’ has been replaced with ‘conversation (script)’
 - ‘interview’ is now listed along with conversation as ‘conversation/interview’ instead of as a separate text type in the list.
