	Cohort	Year 10, 11 and 12 students will be able to sit this window.
	Declaration form	Submission of the completed <u>OLNA Declaration form</u> for the Term 3 Window B must be completed as soon as possible. If the current Principal has already signed the OLNA Declaration form for 2023, they are not required to complete another form and it is not required to be submitted again. If a Principal is new to the school, an OLNA Declaration form will need to be completed and submitted.

	Testing location	All students sitting an OLNA component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices and Browsers	 Schools are responsible for ensuring, that during OLNA test sessions: all applications such as <i>Grammarly®</i> and typing settings are turned off or not available any sidebars in browsers are hidden any Artificial Intelligence (AI) chatbots/search functionality, such as 'Bing Chat' is disabled in browsers.
	Results	Student results will be available via SIRS on Monday, 9 October 2023.
Term 4 window	Cohort	Year 9 and 10 students will be able to sit this window.
	Adjustments	All requests for adjustments must be made through the OLNA Dashboard. Adjustments for Year 9 students can be made now, until 4.00pm Friday , 15 September . New or updated adjustments for Year 10 students only can be made between 8.00 am Monday , 9 October and 4.00 pm Wednesday , 11 October .
	Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)	The WA Government's <u>Cyber Security Policy</u> specifies the measures government agencies are required to implement to minimise the risk of government systems being compromised. Part of this policy requires the Authority to implement Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) when users log in to its systems. From Term 4, MFA will be required when logging into the OLNA Dashboard.
