The Years 11 and 12 Modern Greek ATAR syllabus has been revised for teaching from 2027.

- Rationale and General Capabilities have been updated as part of the WACE Refreshments.
- The following sections of the syllabus have been updated to align with Western Australian versions of other languages syllabuses previously updated, including
 - Organisation of content
 - Representation of the Cross-curriculum Priorities
 - Assessment
 - Reporting.
- Stylistic/editorial changes have also been applied.
- The following content areas are now explicitly referenced in the content section of the syllabus:
 - Text types and kinds of writing
 - Linguistic resources
 - Sound and writing systems
 - Intercultural understanding
 - Language learning and communication strategies.
- The descriptions of the following content areas have been updated:
 - Themes, topics and sub-topics
 - Text types and kinds of writing.

No content dot points have been added or deleted.
- The following changes have been made to the information about assessment:
 - a section titled Assessment has been included
 - in the section titled School-based assessment, the assessment tables for Years 11 and 12 have been separated with assessment type weightings and descriptions updated
 - in-depth study is no longer included.
- The following section has been removed to align with the Modern Greek Continuers syllabus from the South Australian Certificate of Education Board:
