

Online EAL/D eligibility declaration checklist

To enrol in the Year 12 English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EAL/D) Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) course, you must submit an online EAL/D eligibility declaration to your school principal or delegate via the <u>student portal</u> (https://studentportal.scsa.wa.edu.au).

Logging in to the student portal

To log in to the student portal, you will need your **WA student number**, which you will find on your school report/s. It may also be on your SmartRider.

You will need a **personal email address** and must be able to access your personal email account when you complete your online declaration.
