<del>Content area</del>	<del>Percentage of exam</del>
<del>Calculus and logarithmic functions</del>	<del>50–60%</del>
<del>Random variables (DRV's and CRV's)</del>	<del>25–30%</del>
<del>Interval estimates</del>	<del>15–20%</del>

The candidate is required to demonstrate knowledge of mathematical facts, conceptual understandings, use of algorithms, use and knowledge of notation and terminology, and problem-solving skills.
