Option A

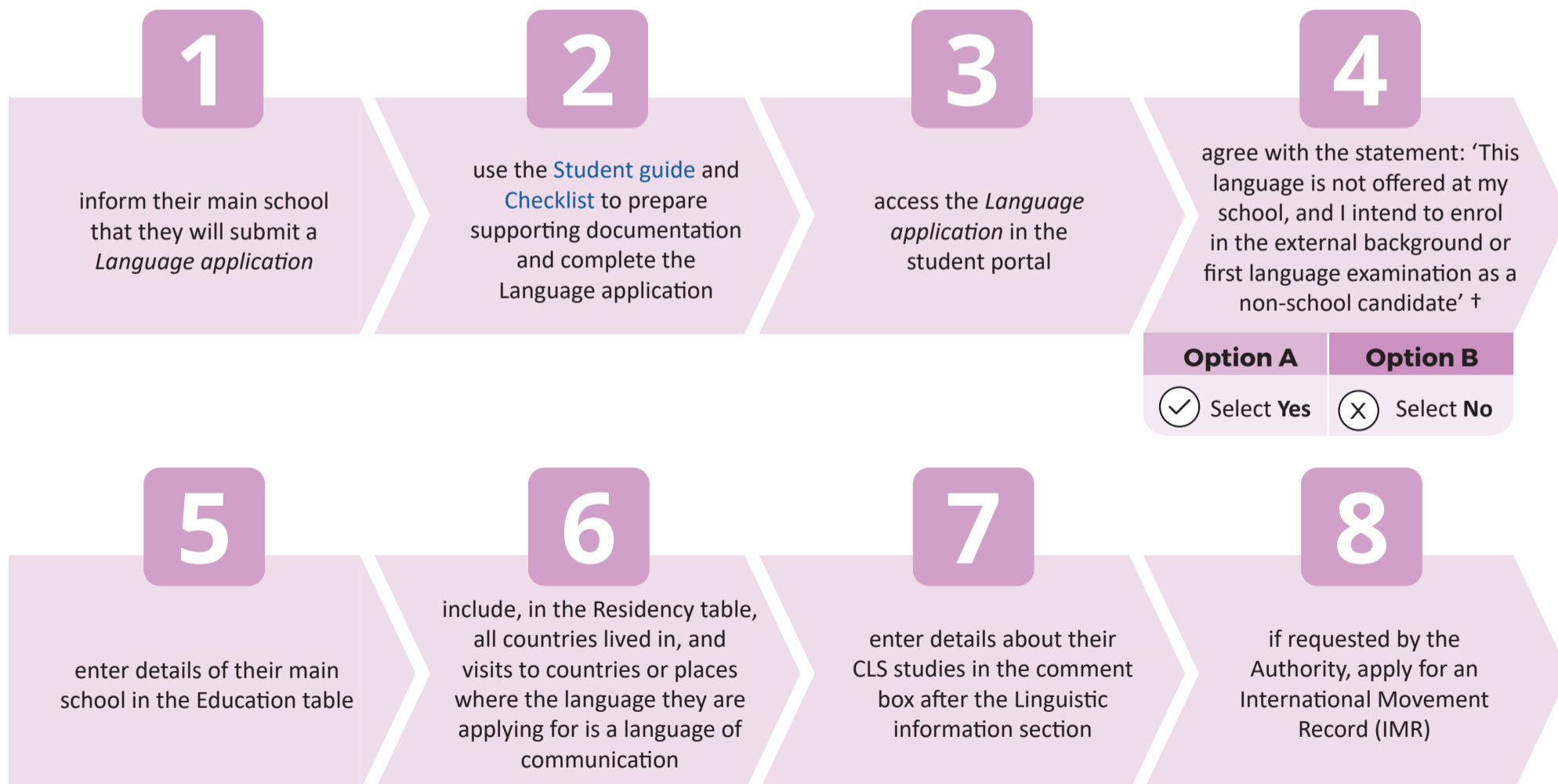
The Community Language Schools prepare Year 12 students to sit the ATAR language examination as a non-school candidate.*

Option B

The Community Language Schools deliver the ATAR language course, including a school-based assessment program, in collaboration with a main/mentor school.*

*For Options A and B, students are required to complete an online *Application for permission to enrol in a WACE language course (Language application)* through the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (the Authority) [student portal](#).

Once students submit their application, it will progress to their main school for school document upload and endorsement, and then to the Authority. The Authority will review the application and, if required, contact the main school to request further information and/or an IMR. The student will receive an email informing them of the course determination.
