The WA Children's Art Institute currently employs contract art tutors to teach drawing and sketching to children. The tutors use paper supplied to them as they need it. They simply sign for the paper in a supply book and an electronic invoice is sent to them by email at a later date.

The tutor data set provided represents a sample of the transaction records from the WA Children's Art Institute, where contract art tutors are required to pick up packets of A4 paper in various colours for their art classes. Traditionally, the process has involved the tutors physically visiting the office to collect the paper packets and sign in a logbook with their name, email and phone number.

Refer to the information below to complete Question 23 parts (a) to (e).

The WA Children's Art Institute is interested in setting up a Wi-Fi network for both the tutors and students to access, and keep this network traffic separate from the administration staff network traffic. There are two buildings 200 m apart, connected by a fibre optic cable. Both buildings are connected to the internet. The WA Children's Art Institute will create this new Wi-Fi service utilising the infrastructure it already has. Currently there is no network diagram, however; the WA Children's Art Institute contains:

- rooms that contain the network switches
- current entry point of the NBN internet connection
- fibre optic cable connection between buildings.

Tutors currently use the cameras in their rooms to transmit real-time live videos of their lectures.

The WA Children's Art Institute would like to enhance security and use IP addresses efficiently while maintaining distinct areas for the main administration staff network and the tutor and student networks.
