## Question 11

(20 marks)

The *Darmasiswa* program is an Indonesian Government initiative which provides students from other countries with one-year scholarships to study at Indonesian universities. It aims to promote friendship, cultural links and understanding among the participants.

You are applying for a scholarship to participate in the *Darmasiswa* program for 2019.

Write a formal **letter** to Ibu Suharti (*Kepala Biro Perencanaan dan Kerja Sama Internasional di Kemdikbud*) of approximately **200** words in **Indonesian**, that includes the following:

- a personal introduction
- a statement explaining why you want to be part of the *Darmasiswa* program
- details of how you hope your study will contribute to your understanding of Indonesia
- information about the fields of work that interest you and which you believe would enhance the Indonesia-Australia relationship
- a closing statement intended to convince the Indonesian Government to select you.
