



## English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EAL/D) eligibility process for Year 12 enrolment

The Year 12 ATAR EAL/D course is available to students who speak English as an additional language or dialect, and whose use of Standard Australian English (SAE) is restricted.

A Year 12 student can only enrol in the ATAR EAL/D course with eligibility approval by the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (the Authority). For a student to gain approval to enrol, an online eligibility application must be completed and submitted to the Authority, along with the required supporting documentation, by the published date. The due dates for submission of applications are located on the EAL/D page of the Authority website: <https://senior-secondary.scsa.wa.edu.au/syllabus-and-support-materials/english/english-as-an-additional-language-or-dialect>.

To complete the online application, the student will need to use a computer, either at home or at school. If you have any questions, ask your child's EAL/D teacher or school administration to help you.

### Five steps in the online EAL/D eligibility process

Step 1: Log in to the student portal: <https://studentportal.scsa.wa.edu.au>

Step 2: Start the EAL/D eligibility application

Step 3: Upload the supporting documents

Step 4: Submit the EAL/D eligibility application

Step 5: Check the student portal for the outcome of the eligibility application process

### Required information

The student will need to provide the following details:

- country of birth
- date of arrival in Australia
- country of birth — mother and father (or carer/s)
- countries previously lived in
- nationality
- languages spoken at home
- details of the schools attended for each school year from Kindergarten

### Supporting documents

The student will need to provide copies of the following documents:

- passport identification page
- date of entry stamp or visa **or**
- international movement record/s
- school report/s

Students will need to save the supporting documents to their computer or mobile device as **.pdf**, **.jpg**, **.jpeg** or **.png** files, with a **maximum size of 4MB** for each file. **Word** documents will **not** be accepted.
