2022 Term 4 and 2023 Term 1 windows

	New testing windows	Principals were sent a letter from the Chair of the School Curriculum and Standards Authority on Monday, 22 August 2022, explaining the introduction of new OLNA testing windows. The new test windows will allow schools more flexibility for testing students and prevent the overlap of OLNA with the early delivery of NAPLAN in March from 2023.

General	OLNA Contacts	An additional <i>OLNA Contact</i> has been created in SIRS, to allow for additional staff to receive the OLNA updates. The new contact role is called 'OLNA Y9–10 Contact'. The previous 'OLNA School Contact' has been renamed as 'OLNA Y10–12 Contact'. All future OLNA updates and communications will be sent to both contacts. Updating contacts in SIRS is self-administered by the school, and instructions on how to update contacts for 2023 can be found in Section 2 of the Data Procedures Manual available on the Authority website.
	Users access to the OLNA Dashboard	All schools are automatically allocated three accounts to access the OLNA Dashboard. Each account name is comprised of the school code and a letter: • Principal's account has an 'A' appended to the end, e.g. 0000A • OLNA Y10–12 Contact's account has a 'B', e.g. 0000B • OLNA Y9–10 Contact's account has a 'C', e.g. 0000C The Principal's account has a function for creating additional users within the dashboard. An email will be sent to each user when the OLNA Dashboard opens.

LAN006 – OLNA individual student current status Lists the current OLNA performance in each component for individual students. It also lists the requirement for individual students who have not demonstrated the standard in at least one component to re-sit the assessment in a future testing period. LAN011 – OLNA Student Accumulative Result Lists current students with their results for each window of the OLNA they have sat.

	Cohort	Only Years 11 and 12 students will be able to sit this window.
	Adjustments	All adjustments (for either disability or EAL/D) must be entered into the OLNA Dashboard by Friday, 10 February 2023 . Students who do not have adjustments entered into the <u>OLNA Dashboard</u> by this date will need to sit without adjustments or wait until the next window.
»	Declaration form	Submission of the completed <u>OLNA Declaration form</u> for the Term 1 window must be completed as soon as possible.
2023 Term 1 window	Reports available through SIRS	 LAN001 – OLNA Student list (Available 2 February) List of registered students eligible to sit the next OLNA window. LAN002 – OLNA Student Login Details (Available 20 February) Lists the usernames and passwords of students eligible to sit the upcoming OLNA window.
	Testing location	All students sitting an OLNA component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications such as Grammarly© and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA.
	Results	Student results will be available via SIRS on Wednesday, 5 April 2023.
