Year 9 students required to sit OLNA	Rationale	The NAPLAN reporting for 2023 has changed from previous years. The new reporting format includes a new scale and proficiency standards to replace bands. To support schools, the Authority has made available reports via SIRS, to identify Year 9 students who have pre-qualified for the minimum literacy and numeracy standard required for the WACE.

Term 3 Window A	Test window	<p>Writing: Monday, 24 July to Tuesday, 25 July Numeracy and Reading: Monday, 24 July to Friday, 4 August</p>
	Cohort	Year 10, 11 and 12 students will be able to sit this window.
	Declaration form	Only if a Principal is new to the school, will the OLN A Declaration form (OLN A Declaration form) need to be completed and submitted.

	Testing location	All students sitting an OLN A component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications such as <i>Grammarly</i> ® and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLN A.
	Results	Student results will be available via SIRS on Monday, 28 August .
Term 3 Window B	<p>Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)</p> <p>The WA Government’s <i>Cyber Security Policy</i> specifies the measures government agencies are required to implement to minimise the risk of government systems being compromised. Part of this policy requires the Authority to implement Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) when users login to its systems.</p> <p>From Term 3 Window B, MFA will be required when logging into the OLN A Dashboard.
