



## Languages enrolment process – Information for parents

All students who wish to enrol in a WACE language course are required to submit an online *Application for permission to enrol in a WACE Language course* to the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (the Authority).

The online application is completed by students while they are in Year 10\*.

To complete the online application, the student will need to use a computer, either at home or at school. If you have any questions, ask your child's Languages teacher or school administration to help you.

### Required information

Your child will need to provide the following details:

- details of the schools attended for each school year from Pre-primary
- school report/s for years where they attended school/s overseas
- countries previously lived in
- countries previously visited
- reason/s for in-country visit/s
- length of in-country visit/s
- the first language/s the student learned to speak
- other language/s the student can speak, read and write
- the language/s the student speaks with their parent/s or guardian/s and with their siblings and friends

### Supporting documents

Your child will need to provide a photograph or scan of the following documents:

- parent/guardian acknowledgement form (mandatory)
- passport identification page, if applicable
- international movement record/s, if applicable
- overseas school report/s, if applicable.

\* This also applies to students in Year 9 who will be applying to undertake a Year 11 Language course.
