Practical (portfolio) examination

Schools are required to submit their candidates' ATAR course Practical (portfolio) examination submissions by **4 pm** on **Tuesday, 20 September 2022**.

Materials required for this examination

To be submitted by the candidate

An ATAR course practical (portfolio) examination submission that must:

- include a Design submission cover page (label) containing a checklist that indicates all documents conform to the practical (portfolio) specifications
- include the Design practical (portfolio) of up to 15 A3 single-sided sheets
- include the completed *References/acknowledgement form*
- be accompanied by a completed *Declaration of authenticity*

Important note to candidates

It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that each item submitted is labelled securely with their WA student number. A candidate's name, names of persons associated with the candidate's school and the school name must **not** appear on any item, nor should the work contain evidence of previous marking.

Any ATAR course Practical (portfolio) examination submitted to the Authority without a completed *Declaration of authenticity* will result in a referral to the Breach of Examination Rules committee.

Structure of the examination

The Design ATAR course examination consists of a written component and a practical (portfolio) component.

Instructions to candidates

3. All single-sided A3 sheets must be:
 - clipped together in one corner by a paperclip and should **not** be presented in a file
 - numbered in the top right-hand corner
 - clearly labelled on the right-hand footer of the page with the candidate's WA student number.
4. This work is not to be submitted by you for any other ATAR course.
