	Test open time	8.00 am to 4.00 pm
	Cohorts	Years 10–12 students will be able to sit this window.
	Adjustments	Adjustment requests for Years 10–12 students must be entered by 4.00 pm Friday, 13 February 2026 .
	Student login details	Student login details will be available via SIRS on Monday, 23 February 2026 . New login sheets are required for each window.
	Testing location	All students sitting an OLNA component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications including writing tools such as Grammarly® and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA. Students who are found with any of these applications or typing settings running may have their test result cancelled.
	Incidents	Information on incidents for OLNA Semester 2 Window 1 (Years 10–12 students) must be entered into the OLNA Dashboard by Friday, 13 March 2026 .
	Results	Results will be available via SIRS on Monday, 30 March 2026 .
