Then respond to a second question in 600 to 800 <i>ji</i> in Japanese Part B: Read one text of approximately 500 <i>ji</i> in Japanese and write a response in approximately 600 <i>ji</i> in Japanese
Writing in Japanese	15%	7.5%	Semester 1 Week 7	Task 2: Individual and society – the impact of a changing society on the individual Production of a written text of approximately 700 <i>ji</i> in Japanese
