Year 9 students required to sit the OLNA	<b>Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) literacy and numeracy requirement</b>	To meet the WACE literacy and numeracy requirement, students may: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• prequalify through the reading, writing and numeracy tests of the Year 9 National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN), or</li> <li>• demonstrate minimum standards of reading, writing and numeracy by successfully completing the relevant components of the OLNA in Years 9, 10, 11 and 12.</li> </ul>
	<b>Reports available through SIRS</b>	The reports available via SIRS for prequalification data on <b>Tuesday, 22 July 2025</b> include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>LAN001 – OLNA Student list</i> List of current students eligible to sit the OLNA for each component. These students have not prequalified.</li> <li>• <i>LAN003 – OLNA Performance Overview</i> Lists all current students and if they have prequalified.</li> <li>• <i>LAN006 – OLNA Individual Student Current Status</i> Individual student reports indicating if, for each component, they have prequalified and which component/s still need to be sat.</li> </ul>
	<b>Information available to distribute to parents</b>	Schools are encouraged to distribute the following prequalification information with <i>NAPLAN Individual Student Reports (ISRs)</i> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• letter to all Year 9 parents explaining the OLNA and prequalification (a copy is attached to this update)</li> <li>• brochure showing the relationship between a student’s NAPLAN ISR and prequalification (a copy is attached to this update)</li> <li>• either <i>LAN006 – OLNA Individual Student Current Status</i> and/or information about parent-facing reporting systems that contain the data from <i>LAN003 – OLNA Performance Overview</i> (exported as a .CSV file).</li> </ul>

	<b>Reports available through SIRS</b>	<p>The reports available in SIRS include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>LAN001 – OLNA Student list</i> List of registered students eligible to sit the next OLNA window.</li> <li>• <i>LAN003 – OLNA Performance Overview</i> Lists the current OLNA results in each component for individual students of the selected cohort.</li> <li>• <i>LAN005 – OLNA Individual Student Diagnostics</i> Individual diagnostics for current students who have achieved a Category 1 or Category 2 result in the selected test window and component.</li> <li>• <i>LAN006 – OLNA Individual Student Current Status</i> This report includes current OLNA performance in each component for individual students.</li> <li>• <i>LAN011 – OLNA Student Accumulative Result</i> Lists the performance progression of registered students by test component.</li> </ul>
<b>Term 3 Window A preparations</b>	<b>Test window</b>	<p>Writing: <b>Monday, 28 July</b> and <b>Tuesday, 29 July 2025</b>.  Numeracy and Reading: <b>Monday, 28 July to Friday, 8 August 2025</b>.  Tests can only be accessed between 8.00 am and 4.00 pm.</p>
	<b>Cohorts</b>	Years 10–12 students will be able to sit in this window.
	<b>OLNA checklists</b>	The <i>OLNA Handbook 2025</i> contains important checklists (Appendices 5 and 6) that will assist schools in preparing for the OLNA.
	<b>Student login details</b>	Student login details are now available via SIRS. New login sheets are required for each window.
	<b>Testing location</b>	All students must sit at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as a VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	<b>Devices</b>	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications including writing tools such as Grammarly® and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA. Students who are found with any of these applications or typing settings running may have their test result cancelled.
	<b>OLNA supervision</b>	OLNA supervisors are reminded to monitor student activity carefully during the test session. Further information can be found in the <i>OLNA Supervisors Handbook 2025</i> .
	<b>Results</b>	Results will be available via SIRS on <b>Monday, 1 September 2025</b> .
