Year 9 students required to sit OLNA	Literacy and Numeracy standard for the Western Australian Certificate of Education	 To meet the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) literacy and numeracy standard, students may: prequalify through the Reading, Writing and Numeracy tests of the Year 9 National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN), or demonstrate the minimum standard of literacy and numeracy by successfully completing the relevant components of the OLNA in Years 9, 10, 11 and 12. To support schools to determine if students have prequalified through
		Year 9 NAPLAN the Authority has produced a number of reports available through SIRS.
	Reports available through SIRS	 The reports available via SIRS on Monday, 15 July include: LAN001 – OLNA Student list List of current students eligible to sit the OLNA for each component. These students have not prequalified. LAN003 – OLNA Performance Overview Lists all current students and if they have pre-qualified. LAN006 – OLNA Individual Student Current Status Individual student reports indicating if, for each component, they have prequalified and which component/s still need to be sat.
	Information available to distribute to parents	Schools are encouraged to distribute the following prequalification information with NAPLAN Individual Student Reports (ISRs): • letter to all Year 9 parents explaining the OLNA and prequalification (a copy is attached to this update) • brochure showing the relationship between a student's NAPLAN ISR and prequalification (a copy is attached to this update) • either LANOO6 – OLNA Individual Student Current Status and/or LANOO3 – OLNA Performance Overview (exported as a .CSV file) to update parent-facing reporting systems.

LAN006 – OLNA Individual Student Current Status Individual student reports indicating, for each component, their current status in each component. LAN011 – OLNA Student Accumulative Result Lists the performance progression of current students by test component.
Term 3 Window A	Test window	Writing: Monday, 22 July to Tuesday, 23 July 2024 Numeracy and Reading: Monday, 22 July to Friday, 2 August 2024
	Cohort	Years 10–12 students will be able to sit this window.
	Declaration form	Only if a Principal is new to the school, will the OLNA Declaration form (OLNA Declaration form) need to be completed and submitted.
	Reports available through SIRS	 The reports available via SIRS on Monday, 15 July include: LAN001 – OLNA Student list List of current students eligible to sit the OLNA for each component. LAN002 – OLNA Student Login Details Lists the usernames and passwords of students eligible to sit the upcoming OLNA window.
	Testing location	All students sitting an OLNA component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications such as Grammarly© and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA.
