	OLNA Contacts	There are two OLNA contact roles in SIRS. These roles, 'OLNA Y9–10' and 'OLNA Y10–12', will both receive all future OLNA updates and communications.

	Users access to the OLNA Dashboard	The Principal and OLNA contacts have an account to access the OLNA Dashboard. Each account name is comprised of the school code and a letter:  Principal's account has an 'A' appended to the end, e.g. 0000A  OLNA Y10–12 Contact's account has a 'B', e.g. 0000B
		OLNA Y9–10 Contact's account has a 'C', e.g. 0000C  The Principal's account has a function for creating additional users within the dashboard.
		Any new users for Term 4 will need to reset their passwords.
	Students in the OLNA Dashboard	New students are loaded into the OLNA Dashboard between 9–10 am each morning.
	OLNA Checklists	Schools are reminded that the <u>OLNA Handbook</u> contains important checklists (Appendices 5 and 6) that will assist schools in preparing for the OLNA.
		Schools are also reminded that all used and unused login sheets should be destroyed. New login sheets will be required for each window.

Term 4 window	Testing location	All students sitting an OLNA component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
Ter	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications such as Grammarly© and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA.
