	Student Login Details	<i>LAN002 – OLNA Student Login Details</i> report will be available via SIRS on Monday, 19 February 2024. This report lists the usernames and passwords of students eligible to sit the upcoming OLNA window.
	Testing location	All students sitting an OLNA component must do so at the school where they are enrolled. The use of anonymiser technology (such as VPN or Tor) that potentially obscures the location of the student is not permitted.
	Devices	Schools are responsible for ensuring that all applications including writing tools such as Grammarly® and typing settings are turned off or not available during the OLNA. Students who are found with any of these applications running may have their test result cancelled.
