Instructions to students

During the preparation

1. Prepare your responses to the visual stimulus item and four focus questions and make notes on the page provided in this preparation booklet.

During the interview

1. Participate in an interview where you will discuss the image and focus questions.
2. The interviewer will ask you at least three of the focus questions to which you will need to respond. Follow up and/or clarifying questions may also be asked.
3. Do not read from your notes.
