Ringkasan keadaan Industri Perfilman Indonesia terkini

Di Festival Film Indonesia 2018, empat film dinominasikan sebagai film terbaik: Film drama *Marlina Si Pembunuh*, film drama percintaan *Aruna dan Lidahnya*, film Sekala *Niskala* dan film biopik *Sultan Agung*. Sebenarnya, film-film terbaik Indonesia biasanya tidak begitu populer di pasaran. Tahun ini, dua film yang paling populer adalah film percintaan remaja *Dilan 1990* yang ditonton sekitar 6,3 juta orang, lalu diikuti oleh film horor *Suzzanna: Bernapas dalam Kubur* dengan 3,2 juta penonton. Meskipun tidak menarik penonton dalam jumlah besar di Indonesia, empat nominasi film terbaik ini merupakan indikator perubahan besar yang terjadi pada industri film Indonesia sejak periode Presiden kedua, Soeharto.

Dari keempat nominasi film terbaik FFI 2018, semua difilmkan sebagian di luar Jakarta dan memperkaya rasa kebangsaan Indonesia lewat eksplorasi berbagai pertanyaan mengenai budaya dan sejarah Indonesia. *Marlina si Pembunuh* yang menyabet 10 piala, termasuk dalam kategori film terbaik, sinematografi terbaik dan pemeran utama perempuan terbaik, berlokasi di perbukitan yang kering dan luas di Sumba, Nusa Tenggara Timur. Film ini kental dengan pesan-pesan feminis yang kuat dan menciptakan genre baru yang disebut *satay western*.

Di *Sekala Niskala*, Kamila Andini menciptakan citra etnografis budaya Bali yang kaya yang menggambarkan keberagaman bangsa. *Aruna dan Lidahnya* merayakan kayanya budaya kuliner Indonesia berdasarkan novel Laksmi Pamuntjak yang diadaptasi untuk film ini. Syutingnya berada di Jawa Timur dan Kalimantan Barat. Sedangkan *Sultan Agung* disyuting di Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta, dimana sutradaranya, Hanung Bramantyo, membuat kisah sejarah sebagai ide cerita yang juga membuat kita berpikir tentang sejarah Indonesia.

Kemunculan sutradara-sutradara Indonesia di festival-festival film internasional adalah sebuah tanda simbolik munculnya generasi baru sutradara film Indonesia yang menunjukkan kekuatan talenta, inovasi, dan kerja keras mereka. *Marlina si Pembunuh* diputar di Festival Film Cannes 2018, sedangkan *Sekala Niskala* telah memenangkan berbagai penghargaan di berbagai festival film internasional seperti di Berlin, Jerman; Buenos Aires, Argentina dan Adelaide, Australia.

Selain itu, cerita di balik penghargaan FFI menunjukkan terjadinya begitu banyak perubahan dan perkembangan di industri film Indonesia selama dua dekade. Juga ada semakin banyak penonton yang menonton film lokal. Jumlah penonton bioskop Indonesia mencapai 42,7 juta pada 2017, atau lebih dari dua kali lipat dari jumlah penonton tahunan dari tiga tahun sebelumnya. Produksi film Indonesia sangat hidup dengan lebih dari 100 judul yang diproduksi setiap tahunnya. Yang terpenting, kualitas film Indonesia sudah mampu menyaingi kualitas film-film terbaik di tingkat dunia. Tahun 2019 akan menjadi tahun menarik untuk disimak bagi industri perfilman Indonesia.
